

Practical Information

The Árborg kindergartens are operated according to the ideology that everyone should have access to education and early intervention. With the aim to ensure diversity and the active participation of everyone. The goal of the early intervention approach in kindergartens is to provide children with suitable education and support. It is important to begin work as soon as possible, in the case of any suspected deviation.

Kindergarten Applications

You can apply for a seat at a kindergarten through the Árborg website *Mín árborg*. Once a child has been enrolled, the parents will receive an email. The kindergarten must be contacted within seven days to confirm the enrollment.

Changes to the Period of Enrollment

Applications for alterations must be submitted before the 15th of each month and goes into effect the 1st of the subsequent month. Applications must be submitted through *Mín Árborg*.

When a Child Stops Attending a Kindergarten

The kindergarten enrollment must be terminated. It must take place before the 15th of the child's last month attending the kindergarten. The termination is announced with a form supplied by the kindergartens director.

School Calendar

Each kindergarten has their own calendar where the main events and closures are announced. The calendar is published on each kindergarten's website.

The kindergarten offer wholesome and tasty food and menus can be found on each kindergarten's website.

Outdoor Activities

The children are taken outside every day and often several times a day. They will need to be supplied with outdoor clothing to suit all weather.
