Parental Leave

Parents are entitled to paid leave, generally for 6 –12 months, at a child's birth, when they adopt a child or take a child into their permanent custody. Parents will either receive holiday pay or parental support from the Maternity/Paternity Leave Fund depending on their job status.

Day care

In Iceland, parents can receive day care services from a day parent if necessary before the child is given a seat at a preschool.

The Icelandic School System

Preschool: Children from 18 months - 6 years of age. Subject to a fee.

Primary School: Mandatory schooling from 6 - 16 years of age. Free of charge.

Secondary Schools: 16 - 25 years of age. The next stage of education following the completion of primary school. Low fee.

Universities: At the completion of secondary school.

12 years old and younger are not permitted to be out in public after 8 p.m. except in the company of adults.13- to 16-year-olds should not be out in public after 8 p.m., unless returning home after attending a sanctioned school, sporting or youth activity event.

During the period of May 1st to September 1st, the children's curfew is extended by two hours.
